- 2011 Non-Disaster Awards from FEMA
 - Should receive anytime
 - Reviewing Project Proposals by end of Nov.
- 2011 LEMPG released, but waiting for clarification from FEMA
- PPD-8 means moving to Core Capabilities instead of Target Capabilities



Local EOP Revisions

- EOP guide local response
- Governor is requesting all jurisdictions have current EOP
 - Current is defined as entire plan reviewed, revised and adopted every 4 years.
 - 118 jurisdictions (86%) have current EOPs



NIMCAST

- How many localities are reporting in NIMSCAST?
 - As of 10/21/2011, 86 localities (61%) have reported their 2011 data in NIMSCAST.
 - 61 localities (43) reporting 100% compliance
 - 95 (67%) localities reported their 2010 data.



Citizen Corps Update

- 12,800 Virginia Medical Reserve Corps volunteers.
 - 2nd Qtr 2011, value of MRC volunteers \$194K
 - During Irene, VA MRC volunteers provided 1,190 hours of support; a value of \$35,400
