

DEBRIS LOAD TICKET

Job Aid

Instructions:

Please use this form to document the type and quantity of debris that is being hauled to the final disposal location.

IMPORTANT!

- VDEM recommends the use of this form to ensure all information required by FEMA is documented.
- If completing this form manually, please print.
- Use the accompanying job aid to understand what data should be entered into each blank.

What is the value of this form?

- Substantiates the type and amounts of debris being hauled.
- Verifies that amounts of debris hauled matches amounts deposited.
- Ensures that costs associated with hauled debris are accurately calculated.

DEBRIS TYPES

- C&D (Construction/demolition – bricks, concrete, framing, drywall, roofing, plumbing fixtures, etc.)
- Electronics (computers, TVs, routers, radios, stereos, printers)
- Hazardous materials (gasoline, diesel fuel, oil, pesticides, herbicides, paint, etc.)
- Household waste (food, trash, clothing, books, paper – trash from homes)
- Mixed (combination of debris types)
- Mud, silt, sand, gravel, rocks, boulders
- Vegetative (trees, shrubs, limbs, branches)
- Vehicles and vessels (cars, trucks, boats)
- White goods (appliances – refrigerators, stoves, microwaves, washer/dryers, dishwashers)



DEBRIS LOAD TICKET

APPLICANT Name of city, county, non-profit agency, etc. applying for FEMA funding.	LOAD TICKET # Number of debris load. Typically provided by Applicant or Applicant's contractor.
TRUCK # Provided by truck driver/operators.	CONTRACTOR Name of Applicant's contracted debris removal service provider. Enter Applicant's name if Applicant is hauling own debris.
TRUCK CAPACITY How many CYs of debris can truck carry full? Reduce capacity for mechanicals inside truck bed.	DRIVER NAME Name of truck driver. Include secondary drivers/operators, as instructed.
DRIVER LICENSE # DL of driver and secondary drivers.	

COLLECTION INFORMATION

LOADING DATE / TIME Date and time of day debris was loaded into truck. Include AM/PM or use military time.	MONITOR NAME Name of individual verifying truck load.
STREET ADDRESS & ZIP CODE Where was debris picked up? If the address is not known, describe location (ex. City Park).	LOCATION / GPS (decimal/degrees) Always enter a GPS for location debris was loaded into truck.
DEBRIS TYPES Check type of debris in load. (White goods are home appliances like refrigerators, stoves, etc.) For electronics, vehicles, or unlisted debris types, select other and describe debris.	DEBRIS LOCATION Describe site where debris was staged prior to loading.

UNLOADING DATE / TIME Date and time of day debris was unloaded at dump site. Include AM/PM or use military time.	LOAD CAPACITY CYs of debris unloaded. Should not exceed max truck capacity above.	TIPPING TICKET # Number of unloaded debris haul as provided by final disposal yard.
UNLOADING SITE NAME Name and permit # of disposal yard or dump site.	MONITOR NAME Name of person verifying unloading and capacity of unloaded debris.	
STREET ADDRESS & ZIP CODE Address of disposal location.	GPS (decimal/degrees) Always enter a GPS for final disposal location.
