Emergency Service Number – to be removed?

- **Not included in NG9-1-1 guidelines**
- **Would this be needed until new technology in place?**

Address Range – to be removed?

- stacked points allow addressing or subaddressing provided unique
- Yea or Nay?



Talking Points

Accommodations for emergency response vehicles (helicopters, rescue boats, as well as wheeled vehicles)

- **Potential to carry incorrect information may outweigh positive information**
- **Excessive “cost” to coding**
- **Land cover will be a better resource**

Talking Points

Street Name Abbreviations

- **Abbreviations should be allowed if, and only if, the abbreviation is the official name from the addressing authority**
- **As opposed what the guy painting the street name sign can fit across the sign**

Talking Points

Neighborhood

Sub-division names provide access point location reference to vehicular access

- **Higher level geo-position reference for “vague” location calls**
- **What cost coding?**
- **Yea or Nay?**



Talking Points

Subaddressing fields

- **Should sub-addressing be broken out into 3 columns: Floor, Unit, Room? (3 fields)**

or

- **Should the sub-addressed number/name be follow by a sub-addressing type that would include the Floor, Unit, Room as a category type? (2 fields)**



Talking Points

Location Type - Define point location as to building, access point, parcel center, or landmark within a parcel

- **Needed for multiple points per addressed site**
- **What cost coding?**
- **Yea or Nay?**

Add data provider field for source not local government

- **Identify contracted source of data**
- **Would address points layer contain a mix of different sources?**
- **Yea or Nay?**
