Local Govt Implementation Plan

Local Govt Implementation Plan

- Identify local project manager to work with AT&T and ISP
- Provides specific implementation steps
 - CHE upgrade
 - GIS data work items
 - Connectivity

- When a locality makes their NG9-1-1 Decision the plan will lay out what a locality needs to do and what assistance and resources they can expect
