9-1-1 and GIS Planning Cycle

- In calendar year 2020, PSC and VGIN will release the next version of their programmatic five-year plans
- We will need the RAC to help ISP with 9-1-1 and GIS planning efforts



9-1-1 and GIS Planning Cycle

- 9-1-1 potential areas of focus
 - Sustainability
 - Currently laser focused on NG9-1-1 deployments (replacement of infrastructure), but how can we leverage ESInet to plan for and address future needs
 - Data consumption



9-1-1 and GIS Planning Cycle

- GIS areas of focus
 - Development of PSAP & provisioning boundaries
 - GIS data maintenance
 - Use of GIS layers beyond NG9-1-1 to encourage local enterprise efforts
