## Latest Round of Funding Requests

- 12 localities submitted NG9-1-1 funding requests that totaled \$8,392,441.32
  - PALs submitted by March 25, 2019
- Requests were reviewed by the PGC during their May 14<sup>th</sup> meeting
- PGC recommends approval of requests

# Overall Program Changes

- Program funding percentage updated to reflect legislative change
- Included language from grant management document that outlines payment request process



## NG9-1-1 Program

- NG9-1-1 Migration Program remains mostly unchanged with the exception of adding progress reports and award amendment requests





## PSAP Education Program (PEP)

- Included subscription based learning programs as an allowable use of funds



## Text-to-9-1-1 Program

- Currently funding available in PSAPs migration proposal
- Transitioning funding program for PSAPs to implement SMS Text-to-9-1-1 prior to NG9-1-1 deployment to meet the required implementation date of July 1, 2020
- Funding limit of \$50,000 and awards



## Text-to-9-1-1 Program

- PSAP that have already implemented Text-to-9-1-1 are not eligible
- Program replaces any funding identified in a PSAP's NG9-1-1 Migration Plan or included in a PSAP's NG9-1-1 funding award



## Text-to-9-1-1 Program

- Funding awards are for 3 years from the date approved by the Board, or until the PSAP deploys NG9-1-1, whichever is sooner
- Funding applications will be reviewed and approved on an ongoing basis throughout the NG9-1-1 deployment period



## FY21 PSAP Grant Guidelines

- The draft document was reviewed by the PGC during their May 14<sup>th</sup> meeting
- PGC recommends approval of the guidelines as submitted
